Primary Responsibilities

Most electrical-maintenance team members at RoyOMartin and its subsidiaries are known as industrial electricians. These highly skilled tradespeople are primarily responsible for safely installing, maintaining, testing, and repairing electrical, electronic, and programmable logic controller (PLC) equipment in a high-production manufacturing environment.

Education and Experience Requirements

Most industrial electricians come to us with some trade-school education, plus several years of experience working in an industrial environment. Critical knowledge includes AC and DC power and control circuits, three-phase power circuits, PLCs, variable-frequency drives (VFDs), standard lockout procedures, and basic-level mechanical aptitude and computer skills.

Safety

Employee safety and wellbeing is RoyOMartin's #1 priority. Through our "I Believe in Zero" philosophy, we believe that all accidents can be prevented. Operating exposures that have injury potential must be eliminated or safeguarded by barriers or operating procedures. Our team members are trained to work safely, from new-hire orientation through ongoing job-specific safety training, and each location has designated safety and occupational-health professionals.

Work Environment

Manufacturing is a highly technical and fast-paced industry, requiring a constant focus on safety and housekeeping. Like similar workplaces, our manufacturing plants are not climate controlled. As such, team members working outdoors may encounter rain, wind, and other elements. As part of our commitment to employee wellness, all RoyOMartin facilities are tobacco free.

Schedule

Our production facilities operate 24/7, with most maintenance team members working 12-hour shifts that begin at 7 a.m. (days) and 7 p.m. (nights). Individuals must be able to work rotating shifts (including nights, weekends, and some holidays) and be available for scheduled and unscheduled overtime as conditions of employment.

Shift schedules like ours, with a 2-2-3 rotation, offer a work/life balance. Team members have 14 days off with every 28-day rotation and a 3-day weekend every other week. Four shifts ensure 24/7 coverage.
